- 3. Principal Report Mrs. Clinkscale Thanks for coming out to the first Bagel Friday. Looking forward to the next one on October 21. The author visit was phenomenal. We really enjoyed hearing her read her book, *Brown is Beautiful*. Tomorrow, October 12, is walk/bike to school. Also, I cannot say enough how great our Howell Nature Trip was this year. Fourth graders look forward to the trip next year.
- 4. Teacher Report Ms. Berger I sent emails to all the teachers to see who wanted to share. I got a lot of responses. Staff wants to thank the mini monthly volunteers for croissants and juice that were provided last month. Katie Russell and all the King staff want to thank the PTO for buying the new books for the book room and thank Katie Dobbie for the digital inventory of the book room. Mrs. Gracey wanted to share that the Howell Camp was amazing and that we will be able to build on this experience for the rest of the year. Mr. Clarkson shared that his class is learning about self control (trying the oreo challenge) and learning how to have fun in school. Also, on October 4, Supriya Kelkar came to King to share her book with King kids on the book's birthday. Everyone really enjoyed the reading. Mr. Hyuck feels a strong sense of appreciation for all the hard work of the PTO.
- 5. Treasurer Report Shalini Jayasundera We posted the proposed 2022-2023 budget on the PTO website and we will leave it up on the website once the budget is approved. So far member contributions are at \$8,857.05 which is over half of what our goal is for this year. We have several fundraising opportunities this year. A couple newer fundraisers this year are the King Fun Run and the King Silent Auction. Our net profit income for this year is \$52,375. The cost of running all events/fundraisers this year is approximately \$13,500, so that will put our gross profit income at \$38,875. Also, a few new things in the budget this year. We have included \$8,000 for all grade level field trips. We haven't been able to do field trips since Covid, so we are excited to be able to send kids on field trips again. Also, we increased the teacher mini grants this year from \$15 to \$20 per student. New teachers will receive an additional \$400 and teachers that changed grades from last year will receive

an additional \$200. Also new this year, every single special teacher will get a mini grant this year as opposed to past years where just each special received a mini grant. A few more new expenses this year are \$3,100 for Staff Appreciation, \$1,000 for the King Community Fund, \$2,000 for 5th Grade End of Year Celebration, and \$2,000 to cover miscellaneous expenses. Total expenses this year are \$48,220 which puts us at a loss of \$9,345. We hope to recoup this loss by getting more donations than anticipated.
